### **Scheduling Zoom Meetings**

To schedule a Zoom meeting, select the **"Meetings"** tab on the lefthand side of the screen, and then click **"Schedule a Meeting."**

# Using Zoom for Music Discovery Sessions

#### Starting Your Music Discovery Session on Zoom

There are two ways you can start your Music Discovery session on Zoom. Start by selecting the "**Meetings**" tab from the home menu. Once you've reached the Meetings screen, drag your cursor over the scheduled session to reveal options to start, edit, or delete your meeting. Click the "**Start**" button to begin your meeting. You may also click on the scheduled meeting from the Meetings screen, scroll to the bottom of the screen, and click the "**Start**" button on the bottom lefthand side of the screen.

### **Utilizing Zoom Features During Music Discovery Sessions**

Zoom offers many helpful settings and features for video conferencing, but you'll only need to use the following features for your Music Discovery sessions. When you first start your meeting, you'll be asked to join with audio, select the **"Join with Computer Audio**" button. It is also important to make sure your microphone is unmuted when you're speaking to your resident by clicking the **microphone icon** located at the bottom lefthand corner of the task bar. You may also turn your camera off and on by clicking the **video camera icon**. When the microphone and video are turned off, a red line will appear over both icons.

When you're ready to play music for the resident, click the green **"Share Screen"** button located in the center of the task bar.



After clicking the **"Screen Share"** button, a pop-up menu will appear showing all of the options for media sharing. There are two ways you can share music during your Music Discovery session. The first method is by using the "screen share" function. To use this method, select the **"Screen"** button that appears in the pop-up menu.

The second method will utilize Zoom's audio share function. This allows you to share <u>only the audio</u> played from your computer without sharing your screen. To use this method, select the **"Advanced"** button at the top of the pop-up menu and click on **"Computer Audio."**
